A very long time ago, people in ancient Greece took part in races in Olympia every four years. People from different cities joined in. People called the races the Olympic Games. During the Olympic Games, everyone stopped fighting with each other.





The first modern Olympic Games were in 1896 in Athens, Greece. The modern Olympic Games take place in a different city every four years. Now there are the Summer and Winter Games. There are more sport activities in summer, and skiing and skating games are only in winter. The world's best sportsmen play in the modern Olympics. They win gold, silver and bronze medals when they finish in the first, second or third places.

There are five rings on the Olympic flag: blue, black, red, yellow and green. The Olympic motto is "Faster, higher, stronger".


